Maureen Manore nominated Donna Juleff, Curt Stine seconded.
The Chair called for additional nominations. Hearing none, the nominations for Town Board 3rd Supervisor were closed.

The Chair called for nominations for Town Board 4th Supervisor.

Richard McDermott nominated Josh Manor, Curt Stine seconded.
Donna Juleff nominated Lilly Arbore, Debra Fisher seconded.
The Chair called for additional nominations. Hearing none, the nominations for Town Board 4th Supervisor were closed.

The nominees were given the required election forms.

Richard McDermott made a motion to adjourn the caucus and Charles Thomas seconded it. The vote passed unanimously.
